

Reflection

A Prophet's Heart God comes, and his ways are near to us. God saves in history. Each person's life, each one's history, is the meeting place God comes to. St. Oscar Romero, The Violence of Love

Oscar Romero (1917–1980) became archbishop of San Salvador in 1977. A prophetic voice of the poor, he was martyred at the altar while saying Mass. Romero was canonized in 2018.
