

# Fourth Sunday of Easter May 8, 2022

#### Acts of the Apostles 13:14, 43-52

We now turn to the Gentiles.

#### Psalm 100:1-2, 3, 5

We are his people, the sheep of his flock.

#### **Revelation 7:9, 14b-17**

The Lamb will shepherd them and lead them to springs of life-giving water.

#### John 10:27-30

I give my sheep eternal life.

#### Reflection

Through the readings last week and this week, we are able to watch Peter's transformation from a timid and impulsive "sidekick" into the leader Jesus always knew he would be. Peter has fumbled his way through the gospel since we met him, and Jesus never, ever stopped drawing him close. Even after denying Jesus at the crucial moment, and then hiding in a house after Jesus died, Peter finally finds the guts to stand up, in front of the highest authorities in his community, and call them out.

#### **Hearing Between the Lines**

Fishing is not my husband's profession, but he's a good fisherman. I can guarantee that "No" or "Not so much" would be the answer to almost anyone- stranger or not, on the lake or not- who asked him whether the fish were biting. You just don't ask such deeply personal questions of a fisherman and expect an honest answer.

Likewise, seven experienced fishermen, empty-netted after being on the lake for hours on end, probably don't want the unsolicited advice of a stranger: "Have you thought about checking out the other side of the boat?" Funny, really. It would be like me asking my husband if a different hook or line might improve his results.

I am somewhat surprised that the Stranger on the Shore didn't have a different question for the fishermen: "Hey, where'd you get the nets? I thought you left them behind a few years ago when you followed that guy from Galilee." Would that question have prompted Peter to the same 100-yard splash?

In either case, as Peter learns after breakfast, the only question that truly matters is the question of love.

"Do you love me?"

"Yes."

"Do you love me?"

"What part of yes don't you understand?"

"Do you love me?"

"Really? Is the pope Catholic?"

Okay, so that is not how the conversation went. It would have been way too early for the pope question! True, this fisherman was the rock on which Jesus would build his Church, but that makes this deeply personal exchange even more resonant.

Regardless of our station or vocation in life, discipleship is our profession. And to profess belief in Jesus Christ is to know that at every moment of every day, we are called to love. The question never, ever goes away. The challenge is to sit in Peter's place on the seashore and hear between the lines of Jesus' love question: Feed my lambs. Tend my sheep. Follow me.

With tender loving care for one another—that's how we follow. Encounter after encounter. Without such love, the results of our evangelizing will never be more than a lackluster "Not so much."


