Reflection

Sometimes it's hard to be a Christian. It's easier to follow the trends of the times and do whatever we need to do to fit in with society. But if you read the gospels and listen at Mass, you realize it's not that hard. There's no great secret to being a good person. The saints in heaven didn't stumble upon magical information. They loved the people around them, and God most of all. Do good, love others, and let yourself be renewed and animated by the Eucharist. One can imagine Jesus is just as attentive to the scholar questioning him as Moses was with the Israelites. "And who is my neighbor?" Everyone.

A Power Over All Our Power

The seventy-two could pack lightly because in many cities they would discover that lodging and food were provided for them. However, most importantly, they were being sent with a message: the kingdom of God has come near in the person of Jesus Christ.

Perhaps the new disciples, much like many of us, were a little nervous but mostly excited to be used in service to Christ. But before long, they seemed to get caught up in the short-term success of the mission, their newfound friends, and their abilities that included power over demonic spirits. Likewise, with our rally crowd numbers, signatures on electronic petitions, Instagram and Twitter followers, or speaking invites and publishing contracts, we rejoice that the demonic systems of our world appear to be subject to us in some large or small way.

Then the voice of God reminds us that he saw Satan himself fall from heaven a long time ago, and of course, God has power over all of our power. The trophies that we're clutching belong to him, and the sweetness we taste in our mouths is from a fruit given, not earned.

So while it is fine to celebrate the victories over the systemic evils of one country on one continent of one small planet of the universe, we must not lose sight of the greater triumph. We have been grafted into the family of the Lord of all creation and sent ahead to proclaim the news of his return so that we can invite and prepare a people for his kingdom.



What do you feel you are being called to do in order to help bring about God's Kingdom? Name three things. Would you enlist helpers for those tasks?



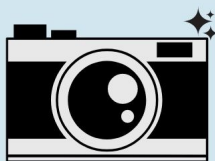
