Reflection

We know that God's values are not out own; we hear this repeatedly in Scripture. But, saturated in a culture that values other things, we forget very easily. We put out time and attention into gathering money and security and social capital, even when we know this is not what Jesus asks of us. Consider the Beatitudes this week and how God might be using them to invite you into letting go of one of these false value.

In This Poverty, Blessed Freedom

In the world of the Beatitudes, God attracts us so powerfully that we turn our eyes entirely toward him (and away from everything else), consecrating ourselves entirely to the glory of God. When our gaze is transfixed on God's glory so that we enter into the mystery of our being, we need to hang a big DO NOT DISTURB sign on the doors of our heart. At this point, God takes over. In order to make our hearts pure and clean, God invites us into a long period of darkness, much like a caterpillar that spins a chrysalis and waits in the shadows of a dormant hope. God comes in with a big bulldozer and starts to work. On the exterior we will experience unexpected reversal: broken relationships, disappointments, failures, illness, and misunderstanding. It will feel like the rug is being ripped out from under us. Indeed, it is, for God wants us to reach our highest ecstasy: to long for him, to cling to him with our whole being, to have nothing to offer of ourselves, to be totally dependent on him for everything: to be poor in heart. Our hearts will break as masks and illusions and scaffolding tumble to the ground, but in this poverty we will discover blessed freedom.

Even in the midst of ruinous circumstances, there will be an interior tug of war between cynicism and hope. In the midst of tears, we will cry out alternately in anger and in the blessed realization that something is emerging within us that is not of our making. God has drawn close to us and entered our solitude to share it with us, to stand in solidarity beside us in our mourning as the crucified and resurrected Lord, promising us life.




Grades 6-12 Retreat
