Reflection

In the contemporary Western world, Christians often do not face the sort of persecutions encountered by the disciples. For us, courageous faith is still needed but occurs in much more subtle ways: in standing up for truth in a conversation with a loved one, in treating those with love whose choices might make us uncomfortable. Wherever and whenever we need courage, God goes with us, seeing our fears and accompanying us through them.

A Mighty Champion

"Fear no one," Jesus says. It is one of his favorite things to tell us. "Do not be afraid."

Easier said than done.

Some 12-step programs use an acronym of the word "fear" as a tool to dispel actual fear: "Future Events Appear Real." I remember being struck by that saying when I heard it. How often have I worried about things that might not happen, or fretted about situations over which I have no control? My mother blamed her insomnia on the fact that as soon as she got into bed, she mentally ticked through all the terrible things that could happen to us kids. Fear kept her wide awake. She manufactured things to fear. We all do sometimes.

Fear keeps us from acting. Fear keeps us from accepting. Fear, Jesus tells us, thrives on our secrets. I sometimes secretly feel apologetic for being a Catholic. I hardly proclaim my faith from the housetops. I'm afraid of being judged or seeming too intense. My heart wants to acknowledge Jesus before others, but my fear imprisons me.

How much freer would I be if I truly believed like Jeremiah that "the Lord is with me, like a mighty champion?" St. Paul writes that we overcome fear—and sin and death—by "the grace of God and the gracious gift of the one man Jesus Christ." I learn anew that the darkness of fear will always falter in the light of God's grace.


