## Jesus's Temptation

In today's Gospel, Jesus goes into the desert for forty days to pray and is tempted by Satan. He is among wild beasts, and the angels come to minister to him. Jesus needs this time of preparation before he begins his public ministry. What about our own preparation? Is it easy to prepare when illness, suffering, and temptation surround us? How do you prepare yourself and your family for those times that seem to be especially challenging?

## Plumbing the Depth's of Lent

It is striking that, unlike other psalms with similar appeals to God, Psalm 130 does not provide any further description of the psalmist's suffering. This has led some to argue that the real cause of anguish here is not any painful physical or social situation but rather an acute awareness of how sin has compromised our relationship with God. Indeed, verse 3 may even suggest that the real depths out of which one prays this psalm are the realization that sinfulness seems to be an inevitable feature of human existence.

Such a radical view of the human condition requires an equally radical view of repentance. This may already be present in the psalm's opening verse. After all, anyone who is truly aware of the depths of human sinfulness must surely cry to God, not just with one's lips but "out of the depths" of one's innermost being. Only with such a humble recognition of how completely we rely on God's mercy (v. 4) will we be able to take on the psalmist's stance in the second half of this psalm, that of confidently waiting for God's "plenteous redemption."

The presence of Psalm 130 at the beginning of Lent already looks ahead to that which is to come at its end, when God's startling embrace of the depths of human suffering brings redemption from both our sins and the power of death. The undeserved gift of such a new relationship with God is indeed something worth waiting for, even more than weary watchers in the night wait for the light that breaks at dawn.


