

Parish Nurses invite you to Heartsaver® First Aid CPR AED Training Feb 10

February is American Heart Month. Our hearts are precious! Heart disease is the leading cause of death for men, women, and people of most racial and ethnic groups in the United States. One person dies every 33 seconds in the United States from cardiovascular disease. The AHA's Heartsaver First Aid CPR AED course trains participants to provide first aid, CPR, and use an automated external defibrillator (AED) in a safe, timely, and effective manner.

The course will be a blended course with on-line study before the hands-on in-person class on Feb 10. Sarah Ransom, EMT will be our instructor. In addition to her experience as an EMT, Sarah has a heart for providing CPR training in the community. She provides personalized training in a supportive and relaxed manner. You do NOT have to have medical training to successfully complete this course.

The AHA's Heartsaver First Aid CPR AED Course is designed for anyone with little or no medical training who wants to be prepared for an emergency in any setting. The course will cover:

- · First aid basics
- · Medical emergencies
- · Injury emergencies
- · Environmental emergencies
- · Preventing illness and injury
- · Adult CPR and AED use
- · Opioid-associated life-threatening emergencies
- · Optional modules in Child CPR AED and Infant CPR
